COVID-19

There has been a significant rise in COVID cases in the school this week. Please follow these steps to ensure we are all staying as safe as possible;

- ◇ If your child is absent, please use a LFD to test **daily**.
- ◇ Please wear a face mask when speaking to teachers at the classroom doors. We ask you to also wear a mask when visiting the front office/school.
- ◇ Even if you have no symptoms, **Lateral Flow Test** regularly.
- ◇ If your child has **any** symptoms of COVID, please test them straight away. Both LFT and PCR tests are available from the front office.
 - ◇ Continue with social distancing.
- ◇ Keep the school informed of any test results.

Flu Until recovered	Head Lice No need to stay off but school or nursery should be informed	Threadworms No need to stay off but school or nursery should be informed	Tonsillitis No need to stay off but school or nursery should be informed
