This half term our topic will be Treasure Hunters with our class text 'How to Find Gold' by Viviane Schwarz. In English we will be using this text to talk confidently about a picture book and respond to it in a range of ways, exploring the story through a variety of learning including artwork, drama and roleplay. Engage in oral storytelling and bookmaking and write in role from more than one perspective. In maths we will be looking at number, division, statistics, measurement focusing on Length and height and geometry and the properties of shapes.
