### School Uniform Sale

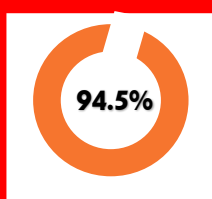
We are having a used school uniform sale at our summer fair. We are welcoming any donations towards the sale and encourage everyone to visit the stall at the summer fair.
