Walk to School Week starts on Monday 16th May.

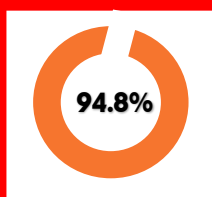

Next week the Year 6 children will be taking their SATs.

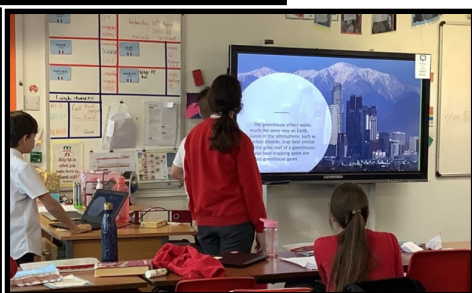
