English – One Day on our Blue Planet

This half term our English will be based on the text 'One Day on our Blue Planet' By Ella Bayley, a fantastic picture non-fiction text about the day in the life of a lion cub in the African Savannah. Showing African animals in their natural surroundings and a wonderful opportunity to explore and extend vocabulary through non-fiction writing and exploring settings and animals through poetry.

RE - What does it mean to belong to a faith community?

We will be learning about the Jewish symbol of belonging, understanding and comparing a Christian and Muslim baptism and compare Christian and Jewish weddings.

PSHE

We will be focusing on the core themes of Health and wellbeing, keeping safe, learning about sun and road safety. As well as Living in the wider world focusing on money and finance.

Maths

In maths we will be looking at halves and quarters focusing on strategies to find halves and quarters and solve worded problems, learning about position and direction, numbers to 100 focusing on the structure of 2-digit numbers and number bonds to 100, time and money.

Geography – African Savannah

Through our geography we will be exploring and using simple maps, discussing what we have seen on a map, making simple maps. We will be identifying similarities and differences between 2 places (African Savannah and a place in the UK).

History Our planet and Travel

Through our history we will be exploring the history of flight, ordering the history of flight and exploring the work of the Wright brothers.

DT – Den making

Through our DT learning we will be discussing and drawing our ideas using words and pictures and making simple models. We will be identifying materials and mechanisms in familiar products as well as using simple construction kits. We will be exploring how structures can be made stronger, stiffer and more stable for our animal hides.

Art

We will be looking back at a previous artist studied during the year, Henri Rousseau, alongside our class text to develop and use a wider range of art and design techniques using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space to create different drawings and paintings.

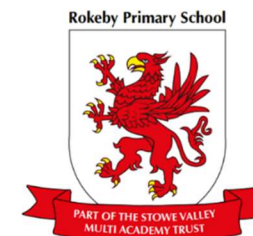
Computing – We Are Detectives

During this unit the children will learn to explore a dataset and understand some data. Use and explore a dataset in 'Popplet' to create a tree for identification of data. Input data into an online form to create a table and create filters to identify subsets of the data.

Physical Education (PE) – unit 4 Creative skills.

The children will be learning to use coordination with their ball skills and counter-balance with a partner. The children will select and link movements together to fit a theme, explore and describe different movements and observe and copy others.

Science – Animals including humans and seasonal changes.

Through our learning the children will identify, name and label the basic parts of the human body as well as naming the five senses. Learning which part of the body is associated with which sense. We will also be observing the changes to the environment that happen in summertime.
