Our Learning during Spring 2

English: we will be exploring and making connections with our own lives, explore and develop ideas through talk, develop creative responses to the text, compose poetry, write in role, develop storytelling techniques, write for a range of purposes and audiences and reflect on reading.

Maths: we will be looking at addition and subtraction within 10, 2D and 3D shapes, numbers to 20, addition within 20 and subtraction within 20.

Geography: we will investigate the climate, physical and human features of Nigeria and compare it to Canada and the school's location in the UK.

Art and DT: we will be looking at designing and printing fabrics in traditional African patterns and preparing an African dish.

RE we are looking Christians and what they believe.

Computing: we will be looking at ways in which technology works through a sequence of instructions.

Science: we will be looking at differences in climate between Nigeria, Canada and the UK as well as countries known to them.
